AUTHORS AND AUTHORS RESPONSIBILITIES

There is no article processing fee.

We publish only original research; multiple submissions are not allowed. By submitting an article to *PJAS*, the author declares that it is their own work and it does not include any plagiarized or ghost-written content. In order to eliminate possible cases of guest-authorship, for a co-authored article, we require a statement of each person's individual contribution.

Authors are expected to follow the recommendations of the reviewers and the editors in the course of the review, editing and publishing process.

Authors are obliged to provide immediate corrections or retractions of mistakes.

If an article is a result of research that has been made possible by a special grant, information about the source of financial support must be provided in the article.

PEER REVIEW PROCESS

The review procedure consists of two stages:

- each submission is first read by two members of the editorial team who qualify it for further review:
- a submission selected by the editors is then sent for a blind review to a specialist in a relevant field of American studies.

In selecting reviewers, the editors of *PJAS* ensure there is no conflict of interest.

Reviewers will provide objective, unbiased judgment of the submitted work.

PUBLICATION ETHICS

PJAS subscribes to the highest ethical standards of academic publishing.

We take all necessary steps to prevent the publication of papers resulting from research misconduct. All allegations of such misconduct will be dealt with immediately and appropriately. We are willing to publish corrections, clarifications, retractions and apologies when needed.

Articles that have been identified as cases of research malpractice will be retracted from the journal.
